SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF TWO (2) AT-LARGE MEMBERS TO THE ARMY BASE STEERING COMMITTEE.

MEETING

DATE: February 2, 2012

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Mayor, with City Council consensus, appoint two (2) at-large Committee members to the Army Base Steering Committee.

BACKGROUND

On August 6, 2009, the City Council created the Army Base Steering Committee which was made up of seven members. This Committee was created to analyze options for the reuse and redevelopment of the Army Base, meet with parties interested in the development of the Army Base, and make recommendations to the City Council, and if necessary the Planning Commission.

Effective December 6, 2011, a vacancy on the Army Base Steering Committee became available due to the resignation of Jerry Rubier. Effective January 25, 2012, an additional vacancy became available due to the resignation of Fred Harris.

REVIEW AND ANALYSIS

In accordance with the Council's direction, Staff advertised for the vacancy in the River News Herald and in the Rio Vista Beacon. As of the January 9th deadline, the City has received interest from the following two (2) applicants.

- Steve Rosenthal
- Rolf Sabye

Term limits have not been established for this Committee. The Mayor, with consensus of the City Council, may appoint the applicants to the Committee.
