

Feasibility Study for a National Heritage Area in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta

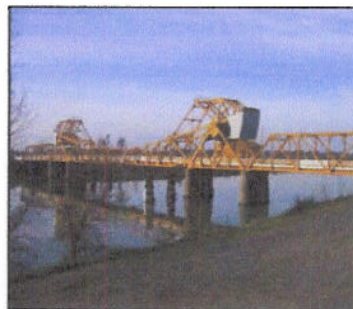
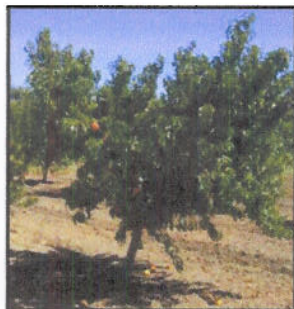
Public Meeting #2
