Those single-family residences, and any future single-family residences, that are required to install one-inch meters for fire-flow purposes were treated as having standard 3/4-inch meters for the purposes of the city's rate study and are expected to be charged at the 3/4-inch meter rate plus the volume charge. Multifamily, commercial, industrial, and retail base customers will be charged a fixed meter rate plus the volume charge.

Single-family residences that are unmetered or whose meters are not being read are charged a fixed monthly rate that is based on the 3/4-inch residential/industrial meter rate plus 20.2 hundred cubic feet (HCF) consumption multiplied by volume rate. 1 HCF = 748 gallons.

B. The monthly metered rate shall be determined by summing the minimum monthly base rate set forth above with the monthly consumption based on the established volume charge for every hundred cubic feet (HCF) of water consumed.

4. Effective July 1, 2011, the volume charge shall be fifty-four cents (\$0.54) per each one hundred (100) cubic feet (seven hundred forty-eight (748) gallons), or any fraction of total water consumed during the month.
