At their regular meeting of July 21, 2026, the City Council will consider the following:

- Minutes of the July 7 City Council Meeting
- The monthly Revenue & Expenditure Fund Balance, Budget v. Actual Status, and Checks Register Reports
- The monthly Informational Report on Current Planning Projects and Properties with Code Enforcement and/or Building Issues
- An Ordinance amending Section 10.12.030 (C) and adding Section 10.12.030 (D) to the Rio Vista Municipal Code providing that signs giving notice of removal of vehicle(s) prohibiting or interfering with a special event must be posted a minimum of twenty-four hours in advance of removal by the City of Rio Vista
- A Resolution establishing maximum garbage collection and disposal rates charged by Rio Vista Sanitation Service, Inc. dba Mt. Diablo Resource Recovery (MDRR); adjusting the residential and commercial rates by 4.00%

Our Solano County dispatchers are dual certified for law enforcement and Emergency Medical Dispatching

Using 911 for non-emergency situations ties up phone lines and delays help for people in critical danger. Examples of non-emergencies include reporting weed issues, general nuisance complaints, traffic/bridge related inquiries, smoke alarm battery replacement requests, or requesting general city information.

For all situations that do not require immediate lights and sirens, please use our non-emergency number instead (707) 374-2233. By choosing the right number, you keep emergency lines open for neighbors who need them most.

2026 Election Nomination Period for City Council Seats

The next Municipal Election in Rio Vista will be on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, to elect two (2) Council Members for four-year terms ending in January 2031. These seats are currently filled by Council Member/Vice Mayor Rick Dolk and Council Member Lisa Duke, whose terms expire January 2027.

The nomination period is July 13 to August 7, 2026. If an incumbent does not file papers, the nomination period for that office will be extended for five calendar days (to Wednesday, August 12). Appointments must be made to both obtain nomination materials and to file nomination papers.
