Municipal Rates and Utility Committee (MRUC)

At the December 14 MRUC meeting, the MRUC, after significant discussion, recommended the City Council implement a one-time maximum rate increase of 16.08% due almost entirely to unfunded State mandates regarding SB 1383 (Organics Recycling). If approved by the City Council, rates will increase by

\$7.82 per month. Implementing the increase on a one-time basis will ultimately save rate payers money in the long run.
