# **California Forever Town Hall**

California Forever (CF) held a Town Hall on December 5<sup>th</sup>, whereby they presented an overview of their project, and residents had the opportunity to ask questions. CF will present their proposition language in January, which should provide further details of the project and commit CF to certain benchmarks prior to construction.

# **Municipal Rates and Utility Committee (MRUC)**

On December 14, the MRUC will consider a recommendation by R3 to increase franchise hauling rates by 16.08% due almost entirely to unfunded State mandates regarding SB 1383 (Organics Recycling). Three implementation scenarios will be considered. Rates, if implemented on a one and done basis, for 64-gallon residential services would increase by \$7.82 per month. MRUC will hear the presentation and potentially make a recommendation to City Council.

#### **Brann Ranch**

Staff met with representatives of Brann Ranch and the School District regarding the negotiation of a new school associated with the Brann Ranch Development project to construct approximately 1,100 homes. The Development Agreement expires in early January.

### **Battery Recycling**
