Point-In-Time Homeless Count

Vice Mayor Okamura and City staff assisted with the Point-In-Time Homeless Count on January 31. The Point-in-Time (PIT) count is a count of sheltered and unsheltered people experiencing homelessness on a single night. The US Department of Housing and Urban Development requires an annual count of people experiencing homelessness in order to qualify for funding.
