#### September 5, 2023, City Council Meeting

The City Council will consider the following items at their September 5 meeting:

- the final reading of the Responsible Beverage Service Ordinance that will require community event organizers to follow State law in terms of responsible beverage service, rather than the current ordinance which is stricter than state law;
- the first reading of an ordinance that will allow a youth commissioner on all commissions;
- a resolution in opposition to Initiative No. 21-0042A1, which if passed would further limit the City's ability to increase taxes and fees; and
- the purchase of one (1) police vehicle.

#### Council Chamber A/V Upgrade

Staff invited quotes from four consultants/firms for A/V solutions in the Council Chamber and received proposals from two. One submittal was essentially non-responsive to the request. Rather than recommending the exclusive remaining proposal without comparison(s), staff is exploring more options.

**Land Swap with the School District**

The City is negotiating a land swap with the School District in order to provide another municipal well location. Options were provided to the School District. The School District relayed concerns about the cost of construction within the business park. City staff will review other potential options and provide a list of construction requirements.

**Joint Facility Use Agreement**

The City made some headway on the Joint Use Agreement with the School District. A draft was provided to the School District for their review on August 30, 2023. The School District will provide a response prior to the next 2x2 meeting.

The City Attorney does not recommend the City be involved in the leagues' uses of school facilities for liability reasons. The good news, it appears the School District is facilitating league usage of school fields for free if a deposit and other legal requirements are agreed to.

**Little Egbert Multi-Benefit Project Feasibility Study Presentation**

Mayor Kott and I received a presentation regarding the Little Egbert Multi-Benefit Project Feasibility Study. The project will improve the condition of levee infrastructure to current standards but will not increase the standard. There also has not been further assessment to conclude the expansion of permanent wetlands directly adjacent to the Rio Vista Municipal Airport will not result in increased bird strike hazards.
