Please be advised that the City of Rio Vista Ordinance specifies:

Title 13, Chapter 13.04 Billing and Collection of charges

- All water charges shall be billed monthly and be due and payable upon receipt and considered delinquent after the 30th of each month, except in February, when it's due on the 28th.
- Meter billings. Water meters shall normally be read at the end of each calendar month and the resulting water charges shall normally be billed and mailed no later than three (3) working days after the 1st of the following calendar month.
- Water customers are responsible for charges, even if they do not receive water bills.
- **The property owner shall be responsible for all bills for water used on the property owner's premises and any and all unpaid bills for water service shall become a lien on the real property and may be collectible by legal action or the Department may refuse service to the premises until the account is paid in full.
