Campaign Overview



The ReFuel Your Fun & \$ave! (RFYF) campaign was developed and administered by the California Product Stewardship Council (CPSC). The campaign helps:

- Promote the use of <u>reusable</u> 1 lb. propane cylinders in lieu of single-use cylinders
- Reduce <u>waste</u> and environmental <u>pollution</u>
- Save local governments & consumers money
- Reduce the hassle of <u>disposal</u>

CPSC has 13 active RFYF projects funded by CalRecycle, including Solano County!



- Develop plans for after current grant period ends (June 2024)
