The City of Rio Vista would like to encourage its residents and visitors to be prepared in the unlikely event of a local emergency or condition that may impact your way of life.

These can be small inconveniences such as short-term power losses, or much larger incidents such as fire or flood. Each household has its own unique needs and risks, so we encourage you to start by identifying your risk. For example: Does someone in your home rely on home oxygen? - Then your risk when the power fails may be higher.
